Donna Garrison hereby referred to as "The Breeder", guarantees this puppy to be in good health, provided with age appropriate vaccinations and treated against intestinal parasites. A health certificate and/or health exam records for this puppy will be provided to the buyer at time of purchase. A new health exam by a licensed veterinarian of the buyer's choice must be performed on this puppy within 3 days of purchase for a Three (3) year health guarantee to remain in effect.

Breeder is NOT responsible for any vet fees or treatment charges incurred at this time. If within 3 days of receipt this puppy is found to have a life threatening illness or condition the puppy must be returned to the breeder with the examining veterinarian's document of proof of said disease or illness within 7 days of purchase. The Breeder will replace said puppy with one of equal value when available or will refund the purchase price if no replacement puppy is available within one (1) year.

If buyer is unable to keep this puppy, at any time during its lifetime for any reason, i.e. due to financial, personal or family hardship, the Breeder reserves the right to take back this puppy to be rehomed at their discretion with NO REFUND, full or part, of original purchase price. If the Breeder is unable to physically take back the puppy the Breeder will assist in finding the puppy a suitable new home. Under No circumstance is this puppy to be resold to a third party or surrendered to any rescue or shelter without the prior knowledge or consent of the Breeder.

The buyer understands that they are committing to lifelong care, in some cases 15 years or more, of a highly intelligent and sensitive animal. Grooming, good diet and exercise are a regular must for the health and well-being of all Standard Poodles. This puppy must be provided a comfortable environment, prompt medical attention, and responsible care. This includes keeping this puppy parasite free and up to date with vaccinations, proper nutrition, which consists of a good quality professional feed given at regular intervals, and fresh water available at all times. The Buyer promises to provide a safe environment for the dog, and never allow the dog to roam freely without proper fencing or supervision.

The puppy/dog will be microchipped in order to facilitate his return if lost or stolen. Proper indoor housing with regular access to outdoors for fresh air and exercise must be provided.

Standard Poodles are happiest when they can be part of and involved with all aspects of family companion life and at no time should they be kept in an outdoor kennel, except as necessary for short periods of time and never in inclement weather, or kept tethered on a rope, chain or cable.

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## Health Guarantee

This puppy is guaranteed to the ORIGINAL PURCHASER for three (3) years from date of purchase against hip dysplasia and hereditary or genetic disease or conditions, including, but not limited to, select orthopedic and certain ocular, cardiac issues or blood disorders which can and are tested for in said puppy's parents. If, within two years, this puppy is found to have a serious physically debilitating or life threatening hereditary or genetic disease or defect, the Breeder will replace the puppy with one of equal value within one (1) year. Breeder does not pay for any veterinary bills or fees. This guarantee does not cover non-hereditary genetic diseases/abnormalities or non-life threatening diseases/abnormalities such as but not limited to: uneven bites, slightly irregular hips, undescended testicles, umbilical hernias. If a genetic disease/abnormality is found in the allotted time, the buyer has the option of returning the dog. If the dog is returned, a replacement dog that is equal in value will be given from the next available litter. If the buyer opts to keep the dog, they understand that they are responsible for the dog and its genetic disease/abnormality. Proof of the examination must be given to validate this guarantee. Proof includes a written statement and a dated signature from the certified veterinarian, name of the vet clinic, and all contact information of the clinic. If the condition is a result of the buyer's own negligence (i.e. hip dysplasia caused by excessive running or jumping), this health guarantee will be null and void. Under these circumstances, the Breeder understands that an emotional bond likely exists between the buyer and the puppy/dog and will NOT require that the affected puppy/dog be returned. Examining veterinarian's documentation must be provided to the breeder within 5 days of diagnosis. If long term suffering or poor quality of life is expected, then euthanasia may be recommended by your vet. In some cases, treatment or surgery may correct a condition or improve puppy/dogs' quality of life. The Breeder reserves the right to a second opinion, at their cost, by a licensed qualified veterinarian of their choice before a replacement puppy is offered.

Any health conditions or internal/external parasites deemed to be caused by environment, neglect, improper care, poor diet or lack of follow-up vaccines or deworming by the buyer or responsible agent are NOT covered by this guarantee and will cause the 2 year health guarantee to be null and void.

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## Spay/Neuter Contract

This puppy is being sold as a family companion and pet with Limited AKC Registration. As such, this puppy is not eligible for exhibiting in Conformation competition at AKC events. Altered dogs may compete in UKC Conformation and other AKC performance events, such as, Agility, Obedience, Rally, etc. Additionally, this dog may not be bred at any time and if pups are produced by this dog they will not be eligible for AKC registration. If at any time the Breeder finds that this dog has produced any puppies the buyer MUST RETURN the dog to the Breeder. If it is found that this dog has had puppies the buyer must also pay the breeder \$10,000. No refund of previously paid monies will be made. Buyer agrees to have this puppy spayed or neutered at their expense by a licensed veterinarian no

sooner than the age of 24 months. Current research shows that early altering (before 24 months of age) may be detrimental to the puppy's future health, growth and development. Proof of spay/neuter must be provided to the breeder before AKC Registration papers will be provided to the buyer.

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The buyer agrees to pay \$2000 after a non-refundable deposit of \$500 for a total of \$2500 in exchange for the Standard Poodle stated below:
